BY THE COMMISSION:

The Nebraska Public Service Commission opened the present docket on its own motion, seeking to administer funding for public safety answering points for the implementation and provision of Enhanced Wireless 911 service for Washington County.

On or about April 16, 2013, Washington County filed a request to use wireless enhanced wireless funds for the purchase of a Computer Aided Dispatch system at a total cost of \$122,160.00. Washington County has advised that costs of the total project are being shared with Douglas and Sarpy Counties. Washington County seeks to use its set aside funding and an additional advance against future funding to cover 55% of its share of the total cost in the amount of \$67,188.00.

The Commission finds that this matter should be set for hearing on **May 22, 2013 at 10:00 a.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln.


