OPINION AND FINDINGS

On or about March 30, 2010, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened the above-mentioned docket, on its own motion, seeking to administer funding for public safety answering points for the implementation and provision of Enhanced Wireless 911 service pursuant to the permanent funding mechanism approved under Docket No. 911-019/PI-118. Funding for Washington County was approved on June 21, 2011.

On March 28, 2012, Washington County filed its application for funding with the Commission pursuant to Docket No. 911-019/PI-118 requesting that the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund (Fund) pay one hundred percent (100%) of the \$91,020.00 in costs for the replacement of its 911 equipment and software. Pursuant to Docket No. 911-019/PI-118, the cost of equipment and software is subject to the wireless/wireline allocation factor. Because Washington County's request would require a deviation from this policy, we find the matter should be set for hearing.

Therefore, the Commission finds that hearing on Washington County's request should be scheduled for May 2, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
