BY THE COMMISSION:

On or about May 1, 2017, Dixon County filed a request to use set aside funds for a hardware refresh of its Emergency Callworks 911 system and Equature voice logging system, at a total cost of \$47,874.28.

The costs are shared costs subject to the wireless/wireline ratio. The wireless ratio for Dixon County for the 2016-2017 funding year is 55% wireless.

The Wireless Enhanced 911 Advisory Board considered the request at its May 8, 2017 meeting and recommended the request be approved.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) adopted the permanent cost model to administer funding for public safety answering points for the implementation and provision of Enhanced Wireless 911 service under Docket No. 911-019/PI-118.

Based upon the request for funding, supporting documentation, and in consideration of the recommendation of the Advisory Board, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the costs requested are eligible under $\underline{\text{Neb}}$. $\underline{\text{Rev}}$. $\underline{\text{Stat}}$. \S 86-465 as costs have been incurred or will be incurred for the purchase, installation, maintenance or operation of telecommunications equipment and telecommunications services required for the provision of enhanced wireless 911 service.

The amount eligible for funding using set-aside funds would be up to \$26,330.85 when utilizing the County's 55% wireless ratio on file with the Commission.

Based upon the above, the Commission finds that use of wireless funding by Dixon County should be approved in the amount of \$26,330.85.

Pursuant to Docket 911-019/PI-118, Dixon County is responsible for paying for that portion of the costs attributable to the provision of landline 911 service.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Dixon County's request to use wireless funds for the purchase of equipment, software and maintenance is hereby approved, as set forth herein in the amount of \$26,330.85.
