The project manager will coordinate with Commission staff on the selection of an independent third party and will provide oversight for the project.

All costs and expenses related to the project manager and the independent third party related to the conduct of the Study will be paid by the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund.

This docket will be the vehicle for any filings or actions necessary related to the Study.
