BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

The Commission is in receipt of a Douglas County Nebraska 911 Assessment Report ("Report") written by its third party consultant, Mission Critical Partners (MCP), related to its investigation of a tragic event which occurred on February 12, 2016. The Report contains information that was provided by persons requesting confidential treatment of such pursuant to the Protective Order entered on March 15, 2016. The Hearing Officer hereby issues this Order to determine the appropriate process for releasing the Report, or any portions thereof, to the public.

Pursuant to the Protective Order, the Hearing Officer may resolve any challenges to confidentiality. The Protective Order provides in pertinent part,

In the event that any person challenges a claim for protection under this Protective Order, the person objecting to the removal of the confidential designation bears the burden of demonstrating the harm that would result from public disclosure of the material for which protection is sought. Any person may challenge the characterization of any document or specific information claimed by the providing person to be confidential in the following manner . . . the person challenging the claim for protection shall do so by filing a motion with the Hearing Officer which identifies with specificity the material challenged and requests a ruling whether a document or information is confidential...Within three business days of service of a motion for determination of confidentiality, the person claiming confidentiality shall deliver under seal all of the relevant documents and information to the Hearing Officer...

Any objection to the release of any portion of the Report which discloses information believed to be filed under seal pursuant to the Protective Order must be filed in writing by an interested person on or before **June 2, 2016**. All supporting

documentation relevant to the objection must be filed on or before **June 7, 2016.**

If the Hearing Officer rules that any such information should be released, such information will be kept under seal for five (5) business days following such ruling in order to provide the person claiming protection to seek a stay or other relief from the Hearing Officer's order denying that person such protection.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Hearing Officer in the above-captioned proceeding that the interested persons are on notice of the potential release of the Douglas County Nebraska 911 Assessment Report as prescribed above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contents of the Report filed by MCP will be kept under seal until further Order.
