BY THE COMMISSION:

On or about November 13, 2014, Sue Vanicek, Director of the Nebraska Telephone Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (Complainant), filed a complaint in this docket alleging a violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. section 86-459(2) (Cum. Supp. 2008). Complainant alleged Respondent failed to timely file with the Commission its quarterly report information as required by section 86-459(2) which was due on or before October 15, 2014. Complainant sought an order assessing administrative fines and ordering Respondent to comply with the reporting requirements.

A copy of the Complaint was served on Respondent via certified mail return receipt requested, on or about November 17, 2014. No answer was filed by Respondent.

Respondent should be ordered to Show Cause why the Commission should not assess civil penalties and administrative costs pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-459(5) and 75-910. The Commission finds that a hearing on this matter should be scheduled for **February 10, 2015** at 1:30 p.m., in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 the Atrium Building, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
