BY THE COMMISSION:

Sarpy County has implemented and is providing Phase I wireless enhanced 911 service to customers of several wireless carriers, and costs of such service have been approved in Application Nos. PSAP-001, PSAP-001.1, PSAP-001.2, PSAP-001.3 and PSAP-001.4.

On September 29, 2003, Sarpy County filed an amendment to the request in Application No. PSAP-001.3, and the Commission is treating such request as a separate application in this docket. The hardware and software upgrade reimbursement amount was incorrectly stated in Sarpy County's Application No. PSAP-001.3 request as a cost of \$62,204.00. The correct amount should be shown as \$64,204.00. To correct this error, an additional \$2,000.00 is being requested to cover reimbursement for the cost of the Centralink 2000 ANI Controller hardware and software, as was the original intent.

The Enhanced Wireless 911 Advisory Board considered the request of Sarpy County in Application No. PSAP-001.3, at its board meetings held January 24, 2003; April 15, 2003; June 4, 2003; and August 27, 2003. The Board ultimately recommended that Sarpy County be granted costs of Centralink 2000 ANI Controller hardware and software, which provides 10/20-digit capability to Sarpy County.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

This request for funding is being processed pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-442 to 86-469 (2002 Supp.), 291 Neb. Admin. Code, Chapter 1, Section 5, and Progression Order No. 5 in Commission Docket No. 911-001, entered July 16, 2002.

Costs requested are eligible under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-465 (2002 Supp.) All costs have been incurred for the purchase, installation, maintenance and operation of telecommunications equipment and telecommunications services required for the provision of wireless E-911.

Because Sarpy County has already purchased the equipment upgrades that are the subject of this application, the Commission finds that upon proof of payment by filing a copy of the invoice and a cancelled check with the Commission, it should directly remit payment for reimbursement to Sarpy County.

Based upon the request for funding and supporting documentation, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request for funding should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Sarpy County's request for funding shall be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon invoice, the Commission shall remit to Sarpy County amounts that comport with this order.
