BY THE COMMISSION:

By correspondence dated August 30, 2002, Cedar County seeks to adjust its approved costs for wireless enhanced 911 service to reflect the withdrawal of Nebraska Wireless as a wireless carrier providing service in Cedar County. Cedar County was approved for funding on April 2, 2002, in Application No. PSAP-007 ("original application") for implementation of wireless enhanced 911 service, including service for Nebraska Wireless customers.

Correspondence from Nebraska Wireless dated September 11, 2002, confirms that the company will no longer offer service in Cedar County.

Cedar County has not yet implemented wireless enhanced 911 service for Nebraska Wireless, thus, no costs for such service have been paid to date.

O P I N I O N       A N D       F I N D I N G S

The Commission finds that approved costs for provision of wireless enhanced 911 service in Cedar County should be reduced by the amount previously allocated for service to Nebraska Wireless customers.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that approved costs for provision of wireless enhanced 911 service in Cedar County shall be reduced by the amount allocated in the original application for service to Nebraska Wireless customers.
