BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed March 7, 2003, Cedar County seeks additional costs of wireless E911 service. Cedar County was approved for funding on April 2, 2002, in Application No. PSAP-007 ("original application") for implementation of wireless enhanced 911 service.

Staff and the applicant have discussed the equipment for which Cedar County seeks reimbursement, and staff has informally recommended that Cedar County delay requesting funding until it begins to make preparations for Phase II, to ensure that the equipment for which it seeks reimbursement is sufficient to meet Cedar County's Phase II needs. The applicant has not withdrawn the request for funding, therefore, a hearing should be set in order to address this matter.
