## BY THE COMMISSION:

By written request for funding received December 7, 2004, Seward County, sought funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses of implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service. Said request was granted on March 22, 2005, approving initial costs of \$36,942.00 and recurring costs of \$3,653.00 per month to implement and provide enhanced wireless 911 service for each of the wireless carriers.

Testing has now been completed and it was determined that more sectors were implemented for each of the wireless carriers than originally anticipated. Therefore, the costs must be amended as follows: initial nonrecurring costs total \$65,442.00 and the monthly recurring costs total \$4,353.00. The increased costs are due to the addition of two cell sites for each of the respective companies.

Furthermore, due to a mathematical error in the original request for funding, the \$36,942.00 in initial costs should have been \$54,942.00. Therefore, the actual increase in initial costs due to the addition of cell sites is \$10,500.00.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Costs requested are eligible under <u>Neb</u>. <u>Rev</u>. <u>Stat</u>. § 86-466 (2004 Supp.) All costs have been incurred or will be incurred for the purchase, installation, maintenance and operation of telecommunications equipment and telecommunications services required for the provision of enhanced wireless 911 service.

Pursuant to 86-466, PSAPs shall be compensated for costs determined by the commission to be eligible. The costs referenced herein have been determined to be eligible pursuant to Progression Order No. 5 in Commission Docket No. 911-001, entered July 16, 2002.

Based upon the request for funding, the results of testing and supporting documentation, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the original request for funding should be amended and the adjusted nonrecurring and recurring costs approved.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Seward County's request for funding shall be amended and the adjusted nonrecurring and recurring costs set forth herein approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon invoice from Alltel, the Commission shall remit to Alltel amounts that comport with this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any government-imposed taxes or surcharges assessed on enhanced wireless 911 charges shall be paid.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission update subscriber and wireless cell site information on a quarterly basis, and that payments to Alltel shall be adjusted accordingly.
