BY THE COMMISSION:

By amended written request for funding received February 11, 2002, Cricket Communications, by and through its authorized agent, TeleCommunications Systems (TCS), sought funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses of implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service for Douglas and Sarpy Counties. The application was granted on February 20, 2002. The applicant inadvertently omitted certain items in its calculation of recurring costs sought in the application, namely, recurring charges for Sarpy County's Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP.) The applicant should have applied for \$5,015.00 per month, instead of the amount originally approved, which was \$,4,175.00 per month.

In addition, the Commission's order of February 20, 2002 did not reference the possibility of increased recurring and non-recurring charges due to future increases in subscriber numbers. Such costs, to the extent that they comport the approved costs in the Commission's February 20, 2002 order, should be paid.

## O P I N I O N            A N D            F I N D I N G S

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that Cricket Communications should be paid \$5,015.00 per month for recurring costs. Costs requested are eligible under *Neb. Rev. Stat. §86-2210 (2001 Supp.)*. The Commission further finds that Cricket Communications shall true-up its subscriber counts on a quarterly basis and that the Commission shall pay resulting non-recurring and recurring charges.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that upon invoice from TeleCommunications Systems,, the Commission shall remit amounts that comport with this order and the Commission's order of February 20, 2002 in this docket.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order clarifies that Cricket Communications shall be paid for non-recurring and recurring charges resulting from increased subscriber counts.

and that Cricket Communications shall true-up its subscriber counts on a quarterly basis.
