T-Mobile is not seeking any funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund to provide enhanced wireless 911 service for Phase I or Phase II implementation.

The Commission further finds that T-Mobile is not seeking funding at this time. Should T-Mobile wish to request funding in the future, it should file with the Commission a request pursuant to the Act and Admin. Code, Chapter 1, Section 5, and Progression Order No. 5 in Commission Docket No. 911-001 entered July 16, 2002.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Implementation Plan submitted by T-Mobile should be and is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should T-Mobile wish to request funding in the future, it shall file with the Commission a request pursuant to the Act and Admin. Code, Chapter 1, Section 5, and Progression Order No. 5 in Commission Docket No. 911-001 entered July 16, 2002
