OPINION AND FINDINGS

On April 1, 1980, City Cab & Transit Co., Inc., and Yellow Cab Co., Inc., both of Grand Island, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as complainants, filed a formal complaint docketed as FC-1134, alleging:

- A. Operation without proper authority;
- B. Discrimination;
- C. Improper rates;
- D. Operation before permission;
- E. Improper safety standards.

On May 27, 1980, Complainants filed a Motion to Dismiss its complaint.

After due consideration of the Motion and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. That the Motion to Dismiss should be granted.
2. That Formal Complaint No. FC-1134 should be dismissed.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Complainants' Motion to Dismiss Formal Complaint No. FC-1134 be, and it is hereby, granted.
