OPINION AND FINDINGS

On this 18th day of October, 1983, the Commission considered the motion for protective order made by Arlyn L. Westergren on behalf of Roger L. Huls dba Huls Transfer in FC-1183. The Formal Complaint was filed by Mills Transfer and Trans-Nebraska Express, Inc.

After hearing oral arguments and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. That the motion for protective order from the Subpoena Duces Tecum should be overruled except that freight bills will be subject to examination only by complainant's counsel and Commission personnel and that accounting data made available should be limited to the profit and loss statements, bank statements, checks and deposit slips relating to the operation of Huls Transfer.
2. That the hearing scheduled for November 4, 1983 should go forward as scheduled.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the motion for protective order filed in FC-1183 be, and it is hereby overruled except that freight bills will be subject to examination only by complainant's counsel and Commission personnel and that accounting data made available should be limited to the profit and loss statements, bank statements, checks and deposit slips relating to the operation of Huls Transfer.
