OPINION AND FINDINGS

On January 12, 1984, K Truck Lines, Inc., a corporation of Ord, Nebraska, Complainant, filed their formal complaint against Rapid Freight Corporation, Defendant, alleging dormancy and willful failure to comply with the provisions of the Nebraska Motor Carrier Act and the rules and regulations of the Commission.

On April 13, 1984, Complainant requested dismissal of the complaint, No. FC-1187.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint, No. FC-1187, should be dismissed as requested.
