OPINION AND FINDINGS

On July 29, 1987, Brown's Crew Car of Wyoming, Inc., dba Armadillo Express, Cheyenne, Wyoming, Complainant, filed its formal complaint against Hotel Managers, Inc., dba Scottsbluff Inn, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, Defendant. Alleging the defendant engaged in transportation of passengers as a common carrier by motor vehicle and as a contract carrier by motor vehicle in Nebraska intrastate commerce without there being a certificate of public convenience and necessity or a contract carrier permit issued by the Commission authorizing such transportation of passengers.

On November 19, 1987, Complainant requested dismissal of the complaint, No. FC-1208.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint, No. FC-1208, should be dismissed as requested.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the request of Brown's Crew Car of Wyoming, Inc., dba Armadillo Express, Cheyenne, Wyoming, Complainant, be, and it is hereby, granted; and that the formal complaint No. FC-1208 filed by Brown's Crew Car of Wyoming, Inc., dba Armadillo Express, Complainant, vs. Hotel Managers, Inc., dba Scottsbluff Inn, Defendant be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
