OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 28, 1989, R & R Xpress, Inc., Falls City, Nebraska, Complainant, filed their formal complaint against American Freight Systems, Inc., Defendant, alleging dormancy and willful failure to comply with the provisions of the Nebraska Motor Carrier Act and rules and regulations of the Commission.

On April 14, 1989, Complainant requested dismissal of the Complaint, No. FC-1222.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint, No. FC-1222, should be dismissed as requested.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the request of R & R Xpress, Inc., Falls City, Nebraska, Complainant, be, and it is hereby, granted; and that the Formal Complaint No. FC-1222 filed by R & R Xpress, Inc., Falls City, Nebraska, Complainant, vs. American Freight Systems, Inc., Defendant be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
