OPINION AND FINDINGS

By complaint filed July 26, 1993, Fritz Trucking, Inc., McCook, Nebraska, alleges that the defendant, Anderson Trucking, has without approval suspended operations and refused to provide pickup and delivery services to the public. However, pursuant to the deregulation of all intrastate carriers except those transporting household goods and passengers on January 1, 1995, the authority granted to Anderson Trucking in Application M-13104 was revoked on January 1, 1995.

From the evidence adduced and being fully informed in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Formal Complaint No. 1238 should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the formal complaint filed by Fritz Trucking, Inc., against Anderson Trucking in Formal Complaint No. 1238 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
