OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On July 25, 2001, the Commission was notified that Sprint Communications Company L.P. and Qwest Corporation had decided to continue to negotiate the one disputed provision in their interconnection agreement concerning reciprocal compensation for enhanced service provider (ESP) (including internet service provider (ISP)) traffic. The Commission entered an order which granted their joint motion and rescheduled the hearing. The hearing in the above-captioned matter is now scheduled for September 25, 2001. The Commission has been advised that the parties are still negotiating; therefore, the Commission will cancel the hearing pending further negotiations. Should the parties find that they cannot reach an agreement through negotiations, the Commission will schedule a hearing on this matter for a time and date to be mutually determined by all of the parties.
