By Application filed April 9, 2019, Windstream Nebraska, Inc. ("Windstream Nebraska") seeks broadband funding from the Nebraska Universal Service Fund ("NUSF") for a Fixed Wireless project to serve the Southern area of the Hebron Exchange. Notice of the Application appeared in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on April 15, 2019. By request filed July 31, 2019, Windstream Nebraska moved to withdraw its application stating it was filed in error, as it duplicated the project approved in NUSF-99.44.¹

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request by the Applicant to withdraw the application in the above-captioned matter, should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the request by Windstream Nebraska, Inc. to withdraw Application No. NUSF-99.52 be, and is hereby, granted.
