BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 28, 2019, CallCatchers, Inc. ("CallCatchers" or "Applicant"), d/b/a Freedom Voice Systems, Carlsbad, California, seeks to withdraw its authority to offer interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 30, 2019. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-4851, Applicant was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. In an application received on October 28, 2019, CallCatchers requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Tariffs within the State of Nebraska. In 2016, CallCatchers was acquired by Media Temple, Inc., an affiliate of GoDaddy.com LLC ("GoDaddy"), a carrier licensed by the Commission to provide interexchange telecommunications services, pursuant to Application No. C-4866. Since the acquisition, Applicant has operated as a wholly owned subsidiary of GoDaddy and has provided service to customers alongside GoDaddy. At the time of the acquisition, the Commission was made aware that all assets and operations was assigned to GoDaddy as part of an internal operational reorganization. As a result, the continued retention maintenance of CallCatchers' certificate would unnecessary and duplicative administrative costs on GoDaddy. The withdrawal of Applicant's Certificate will not impact customers; all services will continue to be provided as they were prior to the operational reorganization.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that CallCatchers' Certificate of Public Convenience and Application No. C-5082

Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-5082 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to CallCatchers, Inc., d/b/a Freedom Voice Systems, to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
