BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 18, 2019, Operator Service Company, LLC ("OSC" or "Applicant"), San Antonio, Texas, seeks to withdraw its authority to offer interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 22, 2019. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

In 1993, by virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket No. C-956, Applicant was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. In an application received on November 18, 2019, OSC requested the withdrawal of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Tariffs within the State of Nebraska. As of February 28, 2019 OSC closed its business operations and currently has no customers in Nebraska or elsewhere. Applicant through this filing requests that its certificate of authority be withdrawn and its tariffs cancelled. The withdrawal of Applicant's certificate will not impact Nebraska customers.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that OSC's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-5085 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to
