By application filed on January 9, 2020, TPUSA - FHCS, Inc., Murray, Utah, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in Dallas, Texas.

Applicant is a corporation, with its headquarters located in Murray, Utah, whose mailing address is 5295 South Commerce Drive, Suite 600, Murray, Utah. Applicant proposes to connect a proprietary in-house built automatic dialing-announcing device with Avaya software, located in Dallas, Texas.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.
