## BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed February 10, 2020, Common Point, LLC, of Chicago, Illinois ("Applicant"), requests cancellation of its authority to operate as a local exchange and interexchange carrier of telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 13, 2020. No protests or interventions were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket C-4425, Applicant was given the ability to offer local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. Applicant now seeks cancellation of its certificates of public convenience and necessity and tariffs within the State of Nebraska. Applicant states that the certificates are no longer necessary because the Company no longer has any customers in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Applicant's Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services should be cancelled, along with all applicable tariffs.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-5096 is hereby granted, and the certificates of public convenience and necessity previously granted to Access Point, Inc., to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
