West Safety Communications, Inc. is authorized to provide local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska.<sup>1</sup> In the present application, West Safety Communications, Inc. requests that the Commission enter an order approving the name change to Intrado Safety Communications, Inc. West Safety Communications, Inc. has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. Based on the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-5099 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of West Safety Communications, Inc. to change its name to Intrado Safety Communications, Inc., is approved.
