On February 19, 2020, the Commission initiated Progression Order No. 6 seeking comments on updates to its Telehealth Program. The Commission, asked a series of questions about restructuring the Telehealth program to account for changes made by the FCC in its 2012 Healthcare Connect Fund Order. Comments were due on or before April 7, 2020. Comments were received by one commenter Prairie Health Ventures, LLC.
