## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 27, 2020, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC, Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of a Resale Forbearance Amendment to the Resale Agreement with Action Communications, Inc., Scottsbluff, Nebraska, for the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 2, 2020. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 252(a) ("the Act"), Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC and Action Communications Inc., entered into a Resale Forbearance Amendment to the Network Interconnection Agreement between the parties, arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the amendment nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review Interconnection Agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Commission finds that this Network Interconnection Agreement should be approved.
