OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed on September 17, 2020, Hudson Bay Company of Illinois, (Applicant), of Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to register the connection of an automatic dialing-announcing device located in Lincoln, Nebraska.

Applicant is an Illinois corporation, whose mailing address is 941 O Street, 6th Floor, Suite 625, Lincoln, NE 68508. Applicant proposes to use an Amcat/Noble CCS model automatic dialing-announcing device.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-691r be, and is hereby granted, and Hudson Bay Company of Illinois, be, and is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the Commission's official registration as set forth in this order and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the Applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in its application within five days.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in accordance with 291 Neb. Admin. Code § 11-004.06, Applicant shall file with the Commission any scripts it intends to use within twenty-four hours of beginning to transmit the message, and include with such filing the registration number of Applicant's device transmitting the script, the date the script first began to be transmitted, and an electronic audio file indicating the run time of the message.
