On March 24, 2020, the Commission issued a Progression Order in the above-captioned docket to provide additional assistance for connecting low-income subscribers to broadband in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic. Historically, the Commission has made support available through its Broadband Adoption program for pilot projects finding that universal service support should be used to assist low-income subscribers in obtaining affordable access to broadband services in their homes. The Commission allocated \$1 million for reimbursement of broadband adoption projects designed to provide free or reduced broadband services to low-income consumers where needed to facilitate online learning.

The following carriers provided broadband services pursuant to the Commission's pilot program structure and should receive NUSF support as follows:
