By Application filed March 30, 2020, Windstream Nebraska, Inc. ("Windstream Nebraska") sought broadband funding from the Nebraska Universal Service Fund ("NUSF") for a fixed wireless project entitled Northwest Lincoln Exchange-RL04 to serve the Northwestern area of the Lincoln, NE ILEC Exchange. Notice of the Application appeared in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on April 2, 2020.

On October 21, 2020, Windstream requested to withdraw this application. Upon consideration of the matter, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Windstream's request to withdraw the application docketed in this matter should be granted. The Commission considers the application withdrawn.
