## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By Application filed November 29, 2018, Windstream Nebraska Inc., (Windstream) seeks high-cost support from the Nebraska Universal Service Fund (NUSF). Notice of the application appeared in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska and the <a href="Geneva Nebraska Signal">Geneva Nebraska Signal</a> <a href="News">News</a>, Geneva, Nebraska on December 4, 2018. No protests or interventions were filed; therefore, the Commission processed this application pursuant to its Rule of Modified Procedure.

On January 8, 2019, the Commission granted the application awarding Windstream support in the amount of Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$13,500.00) for the construction of facilities in the Geneva, Nebraska ILEC Exchange.

On September 22, 2020 Windstream notified the Commission that it was significantly under budget on the projects approved in Application No. NUSF-99.03, but that it was over budget on its projects approved in Application Nos. NUSF-99.14, NUSF-99.32 and NUSF-99.47. Windstream seeks approval to utilize a portion of its approved funding from its NUSF-99.03 project and apply it towards projects approved in Application Nos. NUSF-99.14, NUSF-99.32 and NUSF-99.47 where it was over budget.

As it relates to the Geneva Project, Windstream stated that it incurred increased costs over the original budget amount included in the application. Windstream seeks additional support in the amount of Nine Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars and Forty-Eight Cents (\$9,699.48). In support of its request, Windstream stated that it was required to shift the location further out, resulting in addition \$7,614 in fiber and site work, and an additional \$2,085 in remote equipment costs.

Upon consideration of Windstream's request for additional support, we find it to be reasonable. Accordingly, it shall be approved. The Commission authorizes the additional reimbursement amount of \$9,699.48 for Windstream as requested. The Commission's January 8, 2019 Order shall be modified so that the total of reimbursement for this application shall be \$23,199.48.

#### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Windstream's request for reimbursement shall be, and it is hereby granted.
