BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed November 25, 2020, Legacy Long Distance International, Inc. ("Legacy" or "Applicant"), of Cypress, California, seeks to withdraw its authority to offer interexchange telecommunications services and to cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 2, 2020. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket No. C-1606, Applicant holds a certificate of authority as an interexchange carrier. In this application, Applicant requests that their Certificate of Authority be withdrawn and their tariff cancelled. Applicant has no remaining customers in Nebraska, and the withdrawal of Applicant's Certificates will therefore not impact customers.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Applicant's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications services and all applicable tariffs should be cancelled.

## O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-5190 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to Legacy Long Distance International, Inc. to offer telecommunications service in the State of Nebraska and all applicable tariffs are cancelled.
