### BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 25, 2020, Application was filed by Marsha Lautenschlager ("Applicant") of Doniphan, Nebraska seeking a boundary change to receive advanced telecommunications capability service from the Doniphan Exchange of Hamilton Telephone Company ("Hamilton") in lieu of their current telephone service from Windstream, Nebraska Inc. ("Windstream"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 2, 2020. No protests were filed; therefore, this docket was handled pursuant to the Commission's Rules of Modified Procedure.

### O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

Hamilton and Windstream are local exchange carriers holding certificates of public convenience and necessity to provide local exchange service in their respective territories. Applicant resides within the boundary of Windstream's Hansen Exchange, and has requested a boundary change so that it may receive telephone service from the Doniphan Exchange of Hamilton. Windstream has notified the Commission that it does not oppose the proposed boundary change. Hamilton has also notified the Commission that it is willing to make the boundary change and provide service to the Applicant.

Changes of a local exchange territory are governed by *Neb. Rev. Stat.* §§ 86-135 to 86-138. Section 86-135 states that only upon non-consent of all telephone carriers involved shall the Commission hold a public hearing in the application. With no protest filed by any party and with each of the affected local exchange carriers consenting to the boundary change, the Commission processes this application administratively and without a public hearing.

The Commission staff has modified the Hamilton and Windstream local exchange maps to show the boundary change to the Doniphan Exchange. Copies of the exchange maps with the proposed revisions are attached as Attachment "A" to this Order and hereby

incorporated for reference. If either company has objections or changes to the proposed boundary map, it has until February 24, 2021, to contact the Commission with said objections or changes. If the Commission receives no objections or changes from Hamilton or Windstream by close of business on February 24, 2021 the boundary maps shall be modified as proposed in Attachment "A".

The Commission finds that, in light of the consent between the parties involved, the application is in the public interest and should be granted. It is the expectation of the Commission that the two carriers involved in the boundary change shall collaborate in good faith to ensure that the transition of the customer's service from one carrier to the other shall be as seamless as possible.

## O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-5188 be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on or before February 24, 2021 the parties to this docket shall contact the Commission with any changes or concerns regarding the boundary as proposed in Attachment "A" to this order. If no objection is received from Hamilton or Windstream, the boundary as shown in Attachment "A" to this Order, shall be the official boundary of the two telecommunication companies.
