## O P I N I O N      A N D      F I N D I N G S

On December 31, 2020 CenturyLink filed a request seeking support modifications in the above-captioned docket. CenturyLink requested the Commission reallocate the portion of the projects that were under budget and apply that to the Scottsbluff CR J & 19 project that was over budget. In total, CenturyLink requested reimbursement for the grant amounts previously approved but not yet reimbursed in the amount of \$744,100.

On January 26, 2021, the Commission granted CenturyLink's support modification request. However, the combined grant amount authorized in NUSF-99.07 for projects CR 36 and S, CR 37 and L, CR J and 19, CR R and CR 24, Hunts Dairy Road, Sandberg Road, Wildcat Estates totals \$742,098.32 rather than \$744,100 as requested by CenturyLink. Accordingly, the Commission modifies its January 26, 2021 Order to authorize reimbursement in the amount of \$742,098.32 rather than \$744,100.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission, that the authorized reimbursement in the above-captioned application be, and it is hereby, modified as set forth herein.
