BY THE COMMISSION:

By notice filed January 20, 2021, Windstream Norlight, LLC, Little Rock, Arkansas ("Windstream"), requests cancellation of its authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services and to cancel its tariff in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 20, 2021. No protests or interventions were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

## O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket No. C-3891, Windstream was given the ability to offer interexchange telecommunications service within the State of Nebraska. Windstream now seeks cancellation of their Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Tariff within the State of Nebraska. The Certificate is no longer necessary because the entity currently does not serve any customers.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Windstream's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications service should be cancelled, along with all applicable tariffs.

## O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-5204 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted to Windstream Norlight, LLC, Little Rock, Arkansas, to offer interexchange telecommunication services in the State of Nebraska and the applicable tariff are cancelled.
