By application filed March 18, 2021, Blair Telephone Company ("Blair Telephone") of Blair, Nebraska, seeks approval of an Interconnection Agreement with Midstates Data Transport ("Midstates") of Blair, Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 24, 2021. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 252(a) ("the Act"), Blair Telephone and Midstates entered into an Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement was contained within the application.
