BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On January 5, 2021, an application was filed by LTD Broadband LLC of Las Vegas, Nevada ("LTD Broadband" or "Applicant"), seeking Eligible Telecommunications Carrier designation in Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 7, 2021.

A petition for informal intervention was filed by the Nebraska Rural Broadband Alliance ("NRBA") on June 8, 2021. The NRBA states that the companies it represents have an interest in LTD Broadband's application because the NRBA companies also receive high-cost support from the federal USF and the NUSF. The NRBA states that decisions made by the Commission in this proceeding may have an impact on such support, as well as future financial and policy ramifications for those companies. The NRBA therefore states that it is an interested party to this proceeding.

Pursuant to the Rules of Commission Procedure, 291 Neb. Admin. Code § 1-003.01 *et seq.*, I find that the petition for informal intervention submitted by the Nebraska Rural Broadband Alliance should be granted, and the NRBA should be designated as an informal intervenor in this proceeding. The NRBA should be entitled to participate in the proceeding to the extent of its express interest in the matter and in a manner consistent with 291 Neb. Admin. Code § 1-003.05 and all other applicable Commission Rules of Procedure.


