BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 19, 2021, Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC, Denver, Colorado ("CenturyLink"), seeks approval of a Type 2 Wireless Interconnection Agreement with DISH Wireless, LLC, Littleton, Colorado ("DISH"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 22, 2021. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("the Act"), specifically 47 U.S.C. § 252(a), CenturyLink and DISH entered into a Type 2 Wireless Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement was contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review Interconnection Agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Commission finds the agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Type 2 Wireless Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and DISH Wireless, LLC, shall be, and is hereby, approved.
