BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 19, 2021, Stanton Telecom, Inc., Stanton, Nebraska, ("Stanton") seeks approval of a Wireless Traffic Exchange Agreement with New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, d/b/a AT&T Mobility, Dallas, Texas ("New Cingular"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 25, 2021. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("the Act"), specifically 47 U.S.C. § 252(a), Stanton and New Cingular entered into a Traffic Exchange Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review Interconnection Agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Commission finds that this Traffic Exchange Agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Traffic Exchange Agreement between Stanton Telecom, Inc., and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, d/b/a AT&T Mobility, shall be, and is hereby, approved.
