#### BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 21, 2021, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") received an application from Windstream Nebraska, Inc. of Lincoln, ("Windstream"), seeking a waiver of the requirement contained in 291 Neb. Admin. Code § 5-002.06 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations regarding public pay stations. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 30, 2021. No protests were filed to the waiver sought; therefore, this docket is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

#### OPINION AND FINDINGS

Windstream is a local exchange carrier holding a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide local exchange service in the State of Nebraska. The Commission's regulations at 291 Neb. Admin. Code § 5-002.06 state:

In each municipality served by an exchange carrier where public convenience requires it, the exchange carrier shall supply at least one public pay station that will be available to the public on a 24-hour basis. The requirement for this facility may be waived by the Commission for reasons such as: abusive vandalism or damage, excessive cost of maintaining the pay station, or lack of use.

In its application, Windstream seeks a waiver of the Commission's rule to maintain a public pay station in many of its service territories, as follows:
