BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 3, 2021, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC, of Denver, Colorado ("CenturyLink QC") seeks approval of a Third Party Transit Provider Amendment to its Interconnection Agreement with Dish Wireless, LLC, of Littleton, Colorado ("Dish Wireless"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 5, 2021. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), CenturyLink QC and Dish Wireless entered into an Amendment to their Interconnection Agreement, arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this amendment was contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC and Dish Wireless, LLC, be, and is hereby, approved.
