BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 24, 2021, Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC of Denver, Colorado ("CenturyLink"), seeks approval of an Interconnection Agreement with Clear Rate Communications, Inc. of Troy, Michigan ("Clear Rate"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 1, 2021. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("the Act"), specifically 47 U.S.C. § 252(a), CenturyLink and Clear Rate seek to adopt an Interconnection Agreement previously held between CenturyLink and Teliax, Inc. This adoption of the interconnection agreement was arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement was contained within the application. As part of this application, the Applicants also seek to withdraw the interconnection agreement previously filed and approved by the Commission in Commission Docket No. C-5206. The Applicants state that the agreement filed with the current Application supersedes and corrects the previously approved application.

Neither the adoption of the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. The Commission further finds that the adoption of this agreement shall supersede the previously approved agreement filed with the Commission in Commission Docket No. C-5206.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review Interconnection Agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Commission finds the agreement should be approved.
