The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) hereby opens the above-captioned docket, on its own motion, to determine the surcharge for the statewide Telecommunications Relay System (TRS) for the upcoming fiscal year. The Commission is charged under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-313(2) to hold an annual public hearing before April 1 of each year, in order to determine the amount of the surcharge necessary to carry out the Telecommunications Relay System Act. The surcharge will be used to fund the TRS for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022.

The Commission sets this matter for public hearing on **Tuesday, March 15, 2022, at 11:00 a.m. CDT** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium Building, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
