BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed December 10, 2021, Wauneta Telephone Company, Benkelman, Nebraska ("Wauneta") seeks approval of a Wireless Traffic Exchange Agreement with New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, d/b/a AT&T Mobility, Bedminster, New Jersey ("AT&T"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 15, 2021. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Wauneta and AT&T entered into a Wireless Traffic Exchange Agreement, arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement was contained within the application.

The agreement does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the agreement should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Wireless Traffic Exchange Agreement between Wauneta Telephone Company and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, d/b/a AT&T Mobility be, and is hereby, approved.
