BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed December 10, 2021, Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC of Denver, Colorado ("Qwest") seeks approval of a Reciprocal Compensation Bill and Keep Amendment to the Type 1 and Type 2 Paging Connection Service Agreement with American Messaging Services, LLC of Louisville, Texas ("American Messaging"). Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 28, 2021. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("the Act"), Qwest and American Messaging entered into a Reciprocal Compensation Bill and Keep Amendment to the Type 1 and Type 2 Paging Connection Service Agreement through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement was contained within the application.

The agreement does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the agreement should be approved.
