BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 25, 2022, and pursuant to Commission Docket No. C-2231, Community Internet Systems, Inc., Columbus, Nebraska, requests cancellation of its authority to operate as a local exchange and interexchange carrier of telecommunications services and to cancel its tariff in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 28, 2022. No protests or interventions were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket No. C-2231, Community Internet Systems, Inc. was given the ability to offer local exchange and interexchange telecommunications service within the State of Nebraska. In Docket No. C-5399, Community Internet Systems, Inc. ("CIS") filed a joint application with Applied Connective Technologies, LLC ("ACT") for transfer of control to ACT. CIS now seeks cancellation of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Tariff within the State of Nebraska. The Certification is no longer necessary because neither entity currently offers local exchange or interexchange telecommunications services to their customers.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that CIS' Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to offer telecommunications service should be cancelled, along with all applicable tariffs.
