BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 29, 2022, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered an Order in the above-captioned docket establishing the filing window for its statewide Telehealth program. In its March 29, 2022 Order, the Commission determined that that the state filing window for each funding year should open concurrent with the opening of the FCC filing window, and the state filing window should close 15 business days after the FCC filing window closes. For current fiscal year, FY2024, the federal filing deadline is currently April 1, 2024.

On February 22, 2024, the Commission received a request from Prairie Health Ventures, a third-party filer, to extend the NUSF-57 filing deadline for FY2024 from 15 business days to 60 business days. The request states that additional time would be helpful to ensure that applications are completed accurately, with all required documentation, and that reviewers have minimal information requests to send out.

Accordingly, the Commission finds it appropriate to adjust filing window for FY2024 to close on June 27, 2024.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the FY2024 filing window for the Telehealth program be, and is hereby, extended to June 27, 2024 as provided herein.
