BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 29, 2022, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered an Order in the above-captioned docket establishing the filing window for its statewide Telehealth program. In its March 29, 2022 Order, the Commission determined that that the state filing window for each funding year should open concurrent with the opening of the FCC filing window, and the state filing window should close fifteen (15) business days after the FCC filing window closes.

On March 21, 2025, the Commission received a request from Prairie Health Ventures, a third-party filer, to extend the NUSF-57 filing deadline for FY2025 by sixty (60) business days from the date the federal filing window closes. In the current program year, the FCC extended the federal filing window from April 1, 2025 to June 2, 2025. In light of this extension, the Commission finds it appropriate enter this Order to also extend the NUSF-57 filing deadline for FY2025 accordingly in order to provide interested filers with sixty (60) business days between the federal and state filing window. The NUSF-57 filing window for FY2025 shall close sixty (60) business days from the date the federal filing window closes. This extension of time applies to all interested filers in this proceeding.

In addition, the Commission finds that on a going forward basis, the state window for submissions in the above-captioned proceeding shall close sixty (60) business days after the close of the federal filing window each funding year rather than fifteen (15) business days.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the FY2025 filing window for the Telehealth program be, and is hereby, extended to sixty (60) business days from the date the federal filing window closes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in subsequent years, unless otherwise modified by Commission order, the Commission's filing window for the Telehealth program shall close sixty (60) business days from the date the federal filing window closes.
