OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION

By application filed April 24, 1989, J.C. Penney Co., Inc., Omaha, Nebraska seeks authority to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device.

Applicant is a Nebraska Corporation whose mailing address is 126 New York Mall, Omaha, NE 68114.

Applicant proposes to connect a Microlog Corp automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant advises this Commission that the device will not be used for advertising purposes and has submitted a written transcript of the message being transmitted.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that the application does comply with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding the registration of automatic dialing-announcing devices.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in its application within five (5) days.
