OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed on June 29, 1994, First United Methodist Church, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant proposes to connect a Kolker Systems, Inc., ETS-1500 automatic dialing-announcing device.

Application advises this Commission that the device will not be used for advertising purposes and has submitted a written transcript of the message being transmitted.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that the applicant does comply with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding the registration of automatic dialing-announcing devices.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-210r be and it is hereby granted and First United Methodist Church, Omaha, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's official registration as hereinbefore set forth and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in its application within five (5) days.
